1. My name is ██████████ I live at ██████████

2. I do recall testifying at the murder trial of Robert Jones. At the trial I testified that I picked out Mr. Jones at the lineup. I did pick out Mr. Jones, but I did so because I was shown pictures of Mr. Jones shortly before the lineup.
3. The detective, whose name I do not remember, showed me books of photos at the precinct. I did not identify anyone from the books. I went to the precinct three or four times.
4. The detective then showed me single photos that included what I later learned to be a photo of Mr. Robert Jones. The detectives told me that Mr. Jones had a long criminal record.
5. At the lineup I picked out the person I saw in the ^{photos} photo that had been shown to me.
6. I did make a court-room identification, but I was only identifying the person I had seen in the photos.
7. As regards to the "Ross" bike, I always told both of the detectives and the woman District Attorney who interviewed me that I never saw the name "Ross". I only saw that it was a mountain bike. The detectives showed me pictures of the bike with the name "Ross."
8. I was pressured by the detectives to say that the label on the bike said, "Ross".
9. The detective told me "We got the person who did this. This is the bike he used."

10. I was also pressured by the female District Attorney who kept saying that Mr. Jones had committed the murder and we need you to say it is a "Ross" bike.
11. I spoke to the female District Attorney on several occasions before the trial. On one occasion, I was being prepared for the trial testimony and when I did not mention the bike make, "Ross," the female District Attorney insisted that I remember that it was a "Ross" bike.
12. I never remembered that it was a "Ross" bike. All I said was that it was a "mountain" bike.
13. I have read the above statement and it was also read to me. Everything in this statement is true and correct.
