1. I am over the age of 18 and reside at **[REDACTED]**  
**[REDACTED]**.
2. On the evening of September 9, 1994, I was at **[REDACTED]** house located at **[REDACTED]**.
3. **[REDACTED]** is my brother-in-law.
4. We were watching television when we heard gunshots. I immediately went to the window.
5. The window faces Mott Avenue.
6. I saw a black man on a bicycle speed by to my left on Mott Avenue in the direction of Dickens. The man was wearing a white tee shirt.
7. I did not see anyone else fleeing the scene.
8. My brother in law and I then went out onto the street.
9. We saw a man lying on the ground at the corner of Mott and Eggert.
10. We went over to him. The man lying on the ground told me that ~~the guy on the~~ *he was preaching*

*to the drug dealers and one of them shot me* (JR)  
~~bike in the white tee shirt, who he was preaching to, shot him.~~

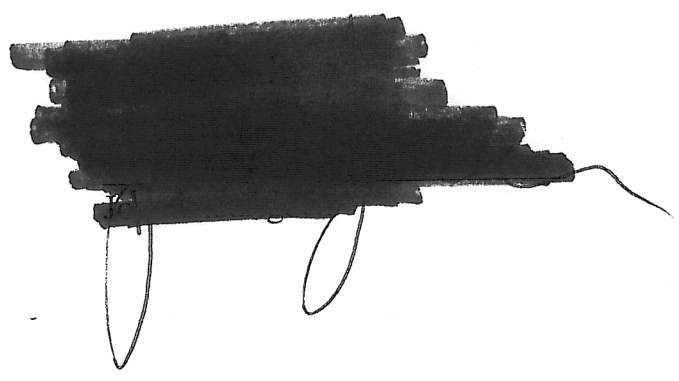
11. I told the police when they arrived that I saw a man wearing a white tee shirt riding his bicycle away from the corner of Eggert in the direction of Dickens Street.

12. I also told the police that the victim told me that he was preaching to a guy *the drug* (JR) ~~on a bike who was wearing a white tee shirt and the man shot him.~~ *dealers and one of them shot him.* (JR)

13. Before the trial I was interviewed by a female District Attorney who was the District Attorney who asked me questions at the trial. She asked me the same questions the police asked me and I gave her the same answers.

15. I was unable to identify the person on the bike. I was not asked to and did not view any mug shots.
